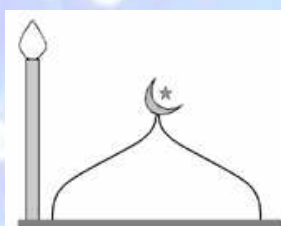


Islamic Awareness Week 27th - 30th of June 2008
