Background Information- Together for Humanity- NT



TOGETHER FOR HUMANITY is a non-profit organisation which models its message by bringing together people from the Christian, Muslim Indigenous and other communities to present educational programs in primary and secondary schools. The workshops, leadership programs, cultural exchange and service projects teach students to accept and embrace others from different racial, religious or cultural backgrounds as equals.



To date *Together for Humanity* has involved more than 50 000 students in five states and territories. Most recently interactive sessions were held at Kormilda, Sanderson Middle School, Anulla and Manunda Terrace in Darwin. Our programs have been independently evaluated and found to be effective. In March 2009 a group of Darwin community members met at MCNT to discuss setting up activity in Darwin. We are considering monthly activity in schools in 2009 and beyond.

Activity has been funded by the Department of Immigration and Citizenship till June 2009.
